PERMIT UNDER THE STREET COLLECTIONS (CONTROL) ACT CHAPTER 21:05

January 21, 2019

Permission is hereby granted by the Commissioner of Police to **Mr. Michael Charles** the Secretary of **South Caribbean Conference of Seventh-day Adventists** located at Corner Eastern Main Road, and Deane Street, St. Augustine to **Solicit Donations** in the streets and places in Trinidad and Tobago, to raise funds to for Social Welfare, for members of families in the community, education, home repair, economic development programs and disaster and famine in the sum of **One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00)**.

This **Permit** is **Valid** for the period **January 21, 2019 to May 26, 2019** between the hours of **8:00am to 6:00pm**.

However the following conditions shall apply: -

- (a) **Fifteen Thousand (15,000)** Donation cards shall be printed for the Soliciting of these Funds.
- (b) There shall not be any interference with the traffic or annoyance to members of the public.
- (c) No person shall assist or take part in the collections or sale without the written authority of the person, Society or Committee to whom this permit is granted, and any person so assisting or taking part must be allotted an area and remain within the allotted area and shall produce such written authority forthwith for inspection by any member of the Police Service on demand.
- (d) No collection or sale shall be made in any part of the carriageway of any street, and no vehicle shall be stopped whilst in motion for the purpose of making sale.
- (e) Every Collector or Vendor shall carry and present to all contributors or purchasers a box or other receptacle securely closed and sealed, and into this box or other receptacle all monies shall be immediately placed.
- (f) No box or receptacle shall be carried or used which does not display prominently thereon the name of the fund for which the collection or sale is being made and all such boxes or receptacles shall be numbered consecutively.
- (g) No payment or reward shall be made or given to any Collector or other persons connected with the collection or sale for or in respect of services rendered in connection therewith.
- (h) **Within one month after the date of the collection or sale a statement shall be forwarded to the Commissioner of Police certified by an Auditor or by some independent responsible person showing in detail the amount collected and the expenses incurred.**
- (i) **Within the same period, a statement shall be published in the Trinidad Guardian or the Trinidad and Tobago Express showing the name of the person or Society or other body responsible for the collection of sale, the amount of the expenses and the amount distributed to the charity or fund. This statement shall be published after audit and a copy of the newspaper shall accompany the statement forwarded to the Commissioner of Police.**
