We therefore, take this opportunity to thank all our members and stakeholders for your prayers and contributions over the past years to bring us to this point. The project will be a reality by God's grace. We want to further engage the commitment of you our churches and constituents in continuing this project.

We are therefore, requesting, that each church give an equivalent of **3% of the total tithe income for 2019 as a gift to this project.** Also, we are soliciting a sacrificial gift, from you the membership, as we seek to raise an additional \$2 million dollars, which we hope you can give during the period March 15 – 30, 2020.
